Screening Requirements for Pre-Applications

Overview of Screening Requirements

NCI incorporates a two-phased application process consisting of a pre and full application. This document provides a rubric for the screening criteria used when evaluating pre-applications. Pre-applications must satisfy all the basic criteria as listed below to be considered for invitation to the full-application. The NCI team, in collaboration with university partners, will use the criteria to ensure that basic requirements are met, and therefore, that the project is eligible for full review.
